Drug Facts

Active ingredients (in each capsule) **Purposes** Diphenhydramine hydrochloride 25 mg..... Nighttime sleep-aid Solubilized ibuprofen equal to

200 mg ibuprofen (NSAID)*. Pain reliever (present as the free acid and potassium salt) *nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug

Uses for relief of occasional sleeplessness when associated with minor aches and pains helps you fall asleep and stay asleep

Warnings

Allergy alert: Ibuprofen may cause a severe allergic reaction. especially in people allergic to aspirin. Symptoms may include: ■ hives ■ facial swelling ■ asthma (wheezing) ■ shock

■ skin reddening ■ rash ■ blisters

If an allergic reaction occurs, stop use and seek medical help right away.

Stomach bleeding warning: This product contains an NSAID, which may cause severe stomach bleeding. The chance is higher if you ■ are age 60 or older ■ have had stomach ulcers or bleeding problems

take a blood thinning (anticoagulant) or steroid drug

take other drugs containing prescription or nonprescription NSAIDs [aspirin.] ibuprofen, naproxen, or others] have 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product
take more or for a longer time than directed

Drug Facts (continued)

Heart attack and stroke warning: NSAIDs, except aspirin, increase the risk of heart attack, heart failure, and stroke. These can be fatal. The risk is higher if you use more than directed or for longer than directed.

Do not use if you have ever had an allergic reaction to any other pain reliever/fever reducer ■ unless you have time for a full night's sleep in children under 12 years of age ■ right before or after heart surgery ■ with any other product containing diphenhydramine, even one used on skin ■ if you have sleeplessness without pain

Ask a doctor before use if ■ stomach bleeding warning applies to you vou have problems or serious side effects from taking pain relievers or fever reducers you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn vou have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, kidney disease, asthma, or had a stroke vou are taking a diuretic vou have a breathing problem such as emphysema or chronic bronchitis ■ you have glaucoma ■ you have trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are

- taking sedatives or tranquilizers, or any other sleep-aid under a doctor's care for any continuing medical illness
- taking any other antihistamines taking aspirin for heart attack or stroke, because ibuprofen may decrease this benefit of aspirin

 taking any other drug

When using this product drowsiness will occur ■ avoid alcoholic drinks ■ do not drive a motor vehicle or operate machinery
take with food or milk if stomach upset occurs

Drug Facts (continued)

Stop use and ask a doctor if

- stomach bleeding:
- stools have stomach pain that does not get better
- chest pain trouble breathing weakness in one
- pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days
- 2 weeks. Insomnia may be a symptom of a serious underlying medical illness.
 redness or swelling is present in the

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use ibuprofen at 20 weeks or later in pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery. Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

Directions ■ do not take more than directed

■ adults and children 12 years and over: take 2 capsules at bedtime do not take more than 2 capsules in 24 hours

Other information

- each capsule contains: potassium 20 mg
- read all warnings and directions before use. Keep carton.
- store at 20-25°C (68-77°F)

■ you experience any of the following signs of

■ feel faint ■ vomit blood ■ have bloody or black

you have symptoms of heart problems or stroke:

part or side of body ■ slurred speech ■ leg swelling

■ sleeplessness persists continuously for more than painful area any new symptoms appear
