vou experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding: ■ feel faint

headache ■ fever ■ vomit blood

■ sinus pressure ■ nasal congestion ■ minor body aches and pains

have bloody or black stools

■ reduces swelling of the nasal passages

have stomach pain that does not get better

you have symptoms of heart problems or stroke:

temporarily restores freer breathing through the nose

chest pain ■ trouble breathing

#### Warnings

Allergy alert: Ibuprofen may cause a severe allergic reaction, especially in people allergic to aspirin. Symptoms may include:

weakness in one part or side of body slurred speech

■ hives ■ facial swelling ■ asthma (wheezing) ■ shock ■ skin reddening
■ rash
■ blisters

■ lea swellina

If an allergic reaction occurs, stop use and seek medical help right away.

■ pain gets worse or lasts more than 7 days fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days.

Stomach bleeding warning: This product contains an NSAID, which may cause severe stomach bleeding. The chance is higher if you:

nasal congestion lasts for more than 7 days

■ are age 60 or older ■ have had stomach ulcers or bleeding problems

symptoms continue or get worse redness or swelling is present in the painful area

■ take a blood thinning (anticoagulant) or steroid drug

- vou get nervous, dizzy, or sleepless
- take other drugs containing prescription or nonprescription NSAIDs [aspirin, ibuprofen. naproxen, or others1
- any new symptoms appear

have 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product

- If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use ibuprofen at 20 weeks or later in pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery.
- take more or for a longer time than directed Heart attack and stroke warning: NSAIDs, except aspirin, increase the risk of heart attack,
- Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

# Directions

Do not use ■ in children under 12 years of age because this product contains too much medication for children under this age

■ if you have ever had an allergic reaction to any other pain reliever/fever reducer right before or after heart surgery

- adults and children 12 years of age and over:
- if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric, or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or for 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI drug. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI. ask a doctor or pharmacist before taking this product
- take 1 tablet every 4 hours while symptoms persist. do not use more than 6 tablets in any 24-hour period unless directed

Ask a doctor before use if

stomach bleeding warning applies to you

by a doctor

- you have problems or serious side effects from taking pain relievers or fever reducers vou have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn
- children under 12 years of age: do not use because this product contains too much medication for children under this age
- vou have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, kidney disease, asthma, thyroid disease, diabetes, have trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland, or had a stroke vou are taking a diuretic

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are

■ store at 20-25°C (68-77°F). Avoid excessive heat above 40°C (104°F). read all warnings and directions before use.
